

Minor criteria for vascular Ehlers-Danlos syndrome⁸

1. Bruising unrelated to identified trauma and/or in unusual sites such as cheeks and back
2. Thin, translucent skin with increased venous visibility
3. Characteristic facial appearance
4. Spontaneous pneumothorax
5. Acrogeria_
6. Talipes equinovarus
7. Congenital hip dislocation
8. Hypermobility of small joints
9. Tendon and muscle rupture
10. Keratoconus
11. Gingival recession and gingival fragility
12. Early onset varicose veins (under age 30 and nulliparous if female)
